HEAD	Distinctive and feminine; warm white in colour; wide forehead; good length from eye to nose - straight to slightly dished and narrowing towards nose; bright lively eyes; black nose.
EARS	Medium size and thickness and black spots desirable; base preferably starting from the wool.
NECK	Average length, well set on shoulders.
SHOULDER	Well set.
BREAST	Wide and well forward
RIB	Long and well arched
BACK	Good length
LOIN	Broad; well joined to rump, well set tail
LEGS	Average length, with no wool lower than hock. Colour - warm white
BONE	Flat
TAIL	The tail should be docked according to the current practice
WOOL	Containing no kemp, of good length, dense and of high quality
RAMS	Hornless

THE LLEYN BREED—THE SHEEP OF THE FUTURE

What is so remarkable about this breed?

Thirty years ago it was almost unknown outside the small Lleyn peninsula which stretches out to the sea towards Ireland in the North West corner of Wales, and is now found in every corner of the British Isles and more recently in Ireland.

There are very good reasons for the spread and growth of the Lleyn, despite the extreme difficulty experienced by non Welsh speaking people in pronouncing it's name

The Lleyn ewe is an excellent mother in all respects. She lambs easily, attends to her newborn lambs without any fuss but with great enthusiasm, whether she is an older ewe or a ewe lamb lambing for the first time. She is an excellent milker and new born lambs are remarkably quick getting on their feet and to suckle, particularly important when lambing takes place outside in weather conditions that are not ideal.

A mature Lleyn flock in regular ages will naturally rear a 200% crop of lambs with ease, while the ewe lamb section of the flock, which are very often mated, will result in a "bonus" crop of lambs.

The Lleyn is a naturally healthy breed and this combined with the ability to maintain a "closed" flock, ensures the maintenance of a high health status flock.

Compared with many other breeds, used to produce prime lamb the Lleyn is smaller in size and enables a higher stocking rate to be maintained and a consequent higher sale of lambs per acre, whether bred pure or crossed with a terminal breed sire, the Lleyn produces highly satisfactory carcase lambs, classified "U"'s and "R" 's, when based on good grassland systems of production, with minimum or nil concentrate use.

The Lleyn ram is also in considerable demand to cross on to other breeds, particularly hill and upland breeds to increase lambing percentages of the resultant breeding ewes, and to improve carcase quality.

The Lleyn is a wonderful ewe, it is little wonder that her fame has, and still is, spreading so rapidly, and that Lleyn breeders are so enthusiastic about her performance.

Conditions of Sale at Society Sales

BALLYMENA (export sale only) CARLISLE, CARMARTHEN, EXETER, NEWARK,
ROSS-ON-WYE, RUTHIN, SKIPTON, STIRLING AND THAINSTONE

ELEGIBILITY

1. Only registered Lleyn sheep aged 5 years and below, and belonging to members of the Lleyn Sheep Society, will be accepted in the Society's official Sales.

ENTRIES

2. Entries to the Sales must be made on the official Entry Forms. All relevant details must be completed in full and, in the case of rams or ram lambs, accompanied by the relevant pedigree cards. Only sheep thus entered will be allowed in the Sale. (However, see para 4). NOTE: If the details are not fully completed the Entry Form will be treated as void.
3. Ram and ram lamb entries are only accepted according to the following sliding scale:
To sell :-
1 ram/ram lamb you must present a minimum of 0 ewes/ewe lambs at the sale
2 rams/ram lambs you must present a minimum of 10 ewes/ewe lambs at the sale
3 rams/ram lambs you must present a minimum of 20 ewes/ewe lambs at the sale
4 rams/ram lambs you must present a minimum of 40 ewes/ewe lambs at the sale
5 rams/ram lambs you must present a minimum of 50 ewes/ewe lambs at the sale
6 rams/ram lambs you must present a minimum of 60 ewes/ewe lambs at the sale
 - Six rams/ram lambs is the maximum that will be accepted at one Sale.
4. The Society will permit one substitute ram or ram lamb per vendor provided the pedigree card for the substitute is presented to the Society's Secretary three clear days prior to the date of the Sale.
5. Members are not allowed to enter the same sheep in two or more of the Society's Sales in the same year.

IDENTIFICATION

6. Tagging/Tattooing
 - (i) Ewes born prior to 2006 - These ewes must be tagged with a Defra (or equivalent) tag in the left ear which also gives the Society management information. In addition, the ewes must be tattooed with the Member's Society flock number in the right ear.
 - (ii) Ewes born in 2006 - These ewes must be tagged with information as defined by Defra (or equivalent) in the left ear and either tagged in the right ear with a Society tag (green tag) showing the Society's management information or, in the event of not utilising a Society tag, the right ear should be tattooed with the Member's flock number. Members electing not to use a Society tag are required to show the Society management information on a tag of their choice.
 - (iii) Ewes born in 2007 - These ewes must be tagged with information as defined by Defra (or equivalent) in the left ear and either tagged in the right ear with a Society tag (white tag) showing the Society's management information or, in the event of not utilising a Society tag, the right ear should be tattooed with the Member's flock number. Members electing not to use a Society tag are required to show the Society management information on a tag of their choice.
 - (iv) Ewes born in 2008 - These ewes must be tagged with information as defined by Defra (or equivalent) in both ears. In addition, the ewe should either be tagged in the right ear with a Society tag (white tag) showing the Society's management information or, in the event of not utilising a Society tag, the right ear should be tattooed with the Member's flock number. Members electing not to use a Society tag are required to show the Society management information on at least one of the double tags.
 - (v) Ewe Lambs born in 2009 - These lambs must be tagged with information defined by Defra (or equivalent) in both ears. One of these tags may be a Society tag (white tag) which carries both Society management information and Defra (or equivalent) information. In the event of not utilising a Society tag, the right ear should be tattooed with the Member's flock number. Members electing not to use a Society tag are required to show the Society management information on at least one of the double tags.
 - (vi) Rams born prior to 2005 - Registered rams must be tagged with a Defra (or equivalent) tag in the left ear which also gives the Society management information. They must also be tattooed with the Member's Society flock number in the right ear. In addition, the left ear of all rams must be tattooed with the year letter and individual number.
 - (vii) Rams born in 2005, 2006 and 2007 - The left ear of all rams should be tagged with information as defined by Defra (or equivalent) and also must be identified with the flock number and the individual number. Rams which have passed the inspection will have the unique Society tag in the right ear (a yellow tag).

- (viii) Rams born in 2008 and 2009 - These rams must be tagged with information as defined by Defra (or equivalent) in both ears. Rams which have passed the inspection will have the unique Society tag in the right ear (a yellow tag for 2008 and spearmint tag for 2009) carrying Society Management information and Defra (or equivalent) information. Provided the ram was born in England, Wales or Scotland, the Society tag can be part of the double tagging set. Society tags used in Ireland only display Society management information.
- (ix) Ram lambs born in 2010 - please ensure that you have properly tagged the ram lambs with EID tag and visual tag.

ALL SHEEP ENTERED MUST BE PROPERLY TAGGED AND TATTOOED AND THOSE NOT CONFORMING WITH THE ABOVE WILL NOT BE ALLOWED IN THE SALE.

PLEASE NOTE THAT TATTOOING IS NO LONGER A NEED AS FROM 2010 ONWARDS.

It is the individual Member's responsibility to comply with the current Government tagging regulations and Members are strongly advised to check the requirements with Defra (or equivalent).

PRESENTATION

7. All sheep must be accompanied by the appropriate Ministry movement licence and, in the case of Maedi-Visna Accredited stock, a Maedi-Visna movement form. In the absence of either form, sheep will not be permitted to unload.
8. All sheep are to be penned as advised on the official sales catalogue. Late arrivals will be refused admission to the sale ring.
9. The sheep will be penned in two sections: Maedi-Visna Accredited and Non Maedi-Visna Accredited.
10. Sheep presented at the sales must be untrimmed. Moreover, the Society discourages artificial colouring of wool. In the event of any sheep creating inspection difficulties, the vendor will, at the discretion of the Inspectors, be asked to wash them.
11. A Member selling in more than one lot must mark each lot differently.
12. Rams presented for sale must NOT be shorn before 1st May and NOT after 15th July.
13. All ewes must be sound in mouth and udder and any complaints for any defects should be reported to the Auctioneers within two hours of the end of the sale. A two-year ewe or over must have reared a lamb, and no ewe shall have run with the ram prior to the sale (the Vendor will be responsible if in default). Rule 77 of the "Livestock Markets Conditions of Sale 1984 Edition for England and Wales" will be enforced.
14. Undocked sheep will not be accepted.
15. All sheep showing forward in teeth must be declared at the time of sale, otherwise they are returnable.
16. A fine of £20 per pen will be imposed if a vendor fails to present his or her sheep on the day of the sale. This fine will also apply to the failure to present a ram or ram lamb previously entered.
18. All prize winners at Shows preceding the Sale must be sold through the ring.
19. A Vendor who has allowed a ram lamb or wether lamb to pass through the Sale and be sold as a ewe lamb will not be paid for that lamb and the Buyer will be refunded the amount paid by him for the 'ewe lamb', the Vendor losing all claims to that lamb, provided that the Auctioneers are informed within 7 days.

DISPLAYS

20. Vendors are allowed to display only the following items on their sheep pens:
 - Flock Boards
 - Rosettes which they have won at the Show before the Sale
 - Official cards issued by Signet
 - National Scrapie Plan certificates (Copies).

SHEEP INSPECTION

21. A panel chosen by the Society's Council will inspect all sheep. Any entry which does not meet the Society's standards will be withdrawn. A Panel chosen by the Society's Council will inspect all sheep. Any entry which does not meet the Society's standards will be withdrawn. NOTE: THE PANEL'S DECISION IS FINAL and any query arising from the Inspectors' decisions should be directed to the Secretary or other Society Representative on the day of the Sale.

ORDER OF SALE

22. The order of the Sale will be: five year old ewes, four year old, three year old, two year old, shearlings and, finally, ewe lambs. The sale of rams will follow except where the circumstances of a particular Sale dictate otherwise, in which case a relevant notice will be printed in the Sale Catalogue.

23. The order of the Sale within these categories will be by a ballot in the presence of a Society representative. The Sale catalogue will be printed strictly in accordance with the outcome of the ballot.

MINIMUM SALE PRICE

24. No rams or ram lambs shall be sold for a price less than 150 guineas. Ewes/ewe lambs are not subject to restriction and will be sold in pounds.

RAM FERTILITY

25. Any ram/ram lamb sold is warranted to be capable of, and effective at, natural service. If such a ram is proved to be incapable or ineffective at natural service and written notice to that effect, supported by a Veterinary Surgeon's certificate, is given by the Purchaser to the Auctioneer within 10 weeks after the Sale date, then the Purchaser may return the ram to the Vendor who shall, at the Purchaser's option, either replace the ram with another ram of equal value, capable of and effective at natural service, or refund the purchase price of the animal together with such costs and charges as the Purchaser may be entitled to.
26. For the purpose of this claim, the Veterinary Surgeon's certificate shall state:
- (i) that the ram's incapacity or ineffectiveness is not the result of injury, accident or illness which had occurred after the time of the Sale;
 - (ii) that, upon examination, the Purchaser's female breeding stock had been found to be in normal breeding condition;
 - (iii) that the Purchaser is not responsible for the ram's incapacity or ineffectiveness.
27. Lambs which are born to a ram which has been proved infertile by a Veterinary Surgeon cannot be allowed registration except by the permission of the previous owner.

ANIMAL HEALTH

28. All sheep must be treated against scab within 28 days before the sale.
Organic sheep farmers - all sheep must be injected against scab as part of your health plan and you must note the treatment in your medicine record (as per Soil Associations' instructions).

DISPUTES

29. In the case of a dispute between a Vendor and the Society in which a Veterinary Surgeon is called, if the Veterinary Surgeon finds in favour of the Vendor, the Society will be liable to pay the veterinary fees. However, if the Veterinary Surgeon finds in favour of the Society, the Vendor will be liable to pay the veterinary fees.
30. A Society Committee will be present to be consulted in the case of disputes.
31. Any complaint should be made to the Auctioneers within 2 hours of the end of the Sale and before the removal of animals from the Sale premises.
32. Any dispute concerning the ear tag numbers of sheep sold at the Sales will be the responsibility of the Vendor and any cost incurred as a result will fall entirely upon the Vendor.
33. If sheep have not been tagged and tattooed correctly, according to the Society's rules (see para 6), the Purchaser may, within 2 hours of the end of the Sale and before removal of the animals from the Sale premises, return the animals to the Vendor and be refunded the purchase price. However, should any disputes arise which involve Maedi-Visna accredited sheep that have been moved by the Purchaser to the non Maedi-Visna accredited section, any claim will be void.

GUIDANCE TO BUYERS

34. Ram and ram lambs will be sold in guineas; ewes and ewe lambs will be sold in pounds.
35. Prospective buyers should please note that, whilst all female sheep have been inspected to the best of the Inspection Panel's ability, it is in your interest to select carefully the sheep that are compatible with your pedigree breeding or commercial requirements.
36. For the benefit of buyers, the definitive year letters/numbers are as follows:

2005 - F, 2006 - 06, 2007 - 07, 2008 - 08, 2009 - 09 2010 - 10.

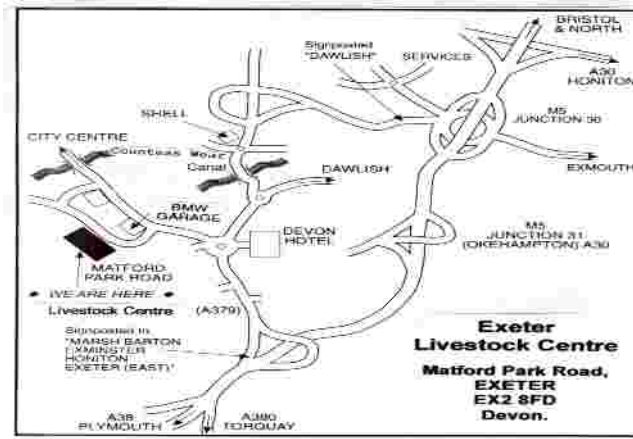
