The Society will be using the same format for the entry form — you can use this form to enter to any of the sales but please remember to <u>clearly write down the sale to which you are entering your sheep.</u> Please complete and answer <u>all</u> questions as the information will be included in the sales catalogue. Also remember to <u>sign</u> the entry form otherwise your entry will not be accepted.

As in the past there are two sections at each sale - one section for maedi visna accredited sheep only and the other section for **all** other sheep (this section to include maedi visna supervised flocks, i.e. flocks which have not received the maedi visna accredited status).

NOTE TO THOSE MEMBERS WHO WILL BE SELLING MAEDI VISNA ACCREDITED SHEEP AT THE SALES: Please complete a valid certificate of accreditation issued by SAC and hand it to one of the Auctioneers' staff <u>before</u> unloading your animals.

**NOTE:** The entry form should be sent to me and not to the Auctioneers. Thank you for your co-operation. (On a personal note – please remember to affix the right amount of postage on the envelope as insufficient postage delays the delivery of your entry to me – a large envelope needs a stamp equivalent to that size).

ENTRIES MUST BE SIGNED AND CAN BE SENT BY WAY OF POST, FAX OR E-MAIL. IF YOU USE FAX OR E-MAIL THE PEDIGREE CERTIFICATES FOR RAMS MUST REACH ME BEFORE THE CLOSING DATE. PLEASE MAKE SURE THAT YOU STATE WHICH SALE YOU WISH TO ENTER YOUR SHEEP TO.

Please therefore complete the paper work straight away and post the entry forms to me in good time before the closing date.

#### Please note:

- (a) All animals (this means ewes, ewe lambs and rams) presented for sale **must** be registered prior to the closing date. There will be spot checks at the sales this year to ascertain whether all sheep have been registered before the sale.
- (b) Remember to enclose the pedigree certificates for the rams entered. As the inspection dates for some venues is late it is anticipated that the pedigree certificates for those yearling rams will not be sent out in time for you to enter if you want to send in your entry forms before receiving the pedigree certificates could you please give me a ring to hold back those certificates for the rams entered for the sale.
- (c) If you wish to enter a **ram lamb** to one of the sales then please do so in the usual manner fill in the enclosed form and the animal will be inspected on the morning of the sale. You must understand that should this ram lamb fail then he will **not** be allowed to be sold through the ring.
  - Please use the same form (enclosed with this letter) if you wish to have your ram lambs inspected at a later date the deadline for receiving applications to provisionally register ram lambs is 30<sup>th</sup> November, 2016.
- (d)All members will have the opportunity to know the reason why his/her animal(s) was/were rejected by the Panel/Inspector. This information will be available by one of the Officials at the sale, immediately after the Panel/Inspector has/have completed his/their work.
- (d) Refer to the sales catalogues for commencement of sale and by what time the sheep should be penned.
- (f) In the event that a Vendor is unable to bring any females to a sale, then that Vendor will only be allowed to sell **one ram** at that sale (not the whole consignment). A Vendor presenting a reduced number of females at any one sale must comply with the existing sliding scale for the number of rams allowed (sliding scale as seen on the back of the entry form).
- (g)The Society encourages members to declare their genotype results of the ram in the comment box on the ram form. The Society will only recognise official DEFRA approved testing.

(h) Enclosed is a polite reminder on sheep health at official Society sales – please have a quick read!

# N.S.A. BUILTH WELLS RAM SALE - 19th SEPTEMBER, 2016

As regards Builth Wells Ram Sale, I have been given to understand that those of you who have sold rams at the Builth Wells Sale last year will receive an entry form automatically for this year's sale. If you wish to sell at the Sale and have not received a form please let me know. May I remind you that the Lleyn Sheep Society's conditions of sale (copy can be viewed on the Society's website <a href="https://www.lleynsheep.com">www.lleynsheep.com</a> or you can request a copy) and the National Sheep Association's sale bye-laws are in force for this sale.

## Please note the following points as regards entering for the NSA sale:

- (a) the entry form should be sent <u>to me</u> and <u>not</u> to the National Sheep Association <u>nor</u> the Auctioneers, Ruthin Farmers;
- (b) **cheques for the N.S.A fee should be made payable to Ruthin Farmers.** Please see the fees due in the N.S.A. Bylaws.
- (c) members will be allowed to enter <u>unregistered</u> Lleyn to this sale.
  - DETAILS OF THESE RAMS ONLY (unregistered rams only) SHOULD BE SENT DIRECTLY TO THE AUCTIONEERS, RUTHIN FARMERS AUCTION CO. LTD., PARC GLASDIR, DENBIGH ROAD INDUSTRIAL ESTATE, DENBIGH ROAD, RUTHIN, DENBIGHSHIRE. LL15 IPB.
  - Details of these rams <u>will not be</u> included in the sales catalogue. These rams will be sold at the end of the registered section.
- (d) for registered rams, the entry form, entry fee (made payable to Ruthin Farmers Auction Co. Ltd) and also the pedigree certificate(s) should be returned to me and not to the Auctioneers by Tuesday, 26<sup>th</sup> July, 2016. NOTE: Please adhere to this request as we are working to the NSA's timetable and have no choice but to conform with their request.
- (e) PLEASE NOTE that all rams <u>must be registered prior to entry</u> but you will be allowed to enter yearling rams which the Inspector has 'put on hold' during the official inspections and also ram lambs. If you fall into either of these categories please:
  - (1) state the centre at which the ram/rams was/were inspected and 'put on hold':
  - (2) let me have details of the ram(s) which is/are 'on hold';
  - (3) complete the necessary form for ram lambs (enclosed with this letter) and return with the appropriate fee please see fees on the attached sheet.

#### ORGANIC SHEEP NO LONGER SOLD SEPARATELY AT EXETER

Please note Exeter Market have been given permission by the Soil Association to sell registered organic stock at this sale within the main ballot (hence all MVA sheep will be sold in one ballot – the organic sheep will not have to be sold first). Organic vendors will need to tick the organic box on the entry form and send the below paperwork:

- A copy of their current organic certificate
- A Trading Schedule, as appropriate
- A Transfer Document

### **REGISTRATION OF EWE LAMBS**

A form has already been sent out to you to register this year's crop of ewe lambs – this can be done online via the Society website, on e-mail through spreadsheet or in paper form. Once I have received the form with the appropriate fee confirmation will be sent back to you with the numbers which you have given me and it is imperative that you check this carefully and if there are any corrections to be made, then please let me know immediately.

The closing date for registering ewe lambs born in 2016 remains the same, 31st December, 2016. However if you are selling ewe lambs at one of the official sales then you must register these at the same time as you are entering your sheep to the sales and tagged according to DEFRA and Society rules.

Please see enclosed a sheet showing the registration fees.

I hope to meet you all at the Lleyn sales, please make every effort to support the Society in order to secure the continued success of your chosen breed.

#### **Notes**

#### I. SALE OF RAMS

(i) Ram and ram lamb entries are only accepted according to the following sliding scale:

To sell I ram/ram lamb you must present a minimum of 0 ewes/ewe lambs at the Sale

2 rams/ram lambs you must present a minimum of 10 ewes/ewe lambs

3 rams/ram lambs you must present a minimum of 20 ewes/ewe lambs

4 rams/ram lambs you must present a minimum of 40 ewes/ewe lambs

5 rams/ram lambs you must present a minimum of 50 ewes/ewe lambs

6 rams/ram lambs you must present a minimum of 60 ewes/ewe lambs

(ii) <u>SIX</u> rams/ram lambs is the maximum that will be accepted at any one Sale. In the case that a Vendor is unable to bring females to a sale, then that Vendor will only be allowed to sell one ram at that sale (not the whole consignment). A Vendor presenting a reduced number of females at any one sale must comply with the existing sliding scale for the number of rams allowed (sliding scale as seen on the back of the entry form).

#### 2. SHEARING, TRIMMING AND COLOURING OF WOOL

It is brought to the attention of all Vendors that:

- (i) The latest date allowed for shearing of sheep is 15th July.
- (ii) NO TRIMMING of male or female sheep prior to the Sale is allowed.
- (iii) The Society discourages artificial colouring of wool.

#### 3. UNOFFICIAL SALES OF STOCK

Your attention is drawn to the fact that the practice of selling rams from the backs of vehicles at Auctioneers' premises during official Sales is prohibited by the Society. The Auctioneers have agreed that any Vendor selling sheep unofficially at the Society Sales will be asked to leave the premises. You are also reminded that, in pursuing this practice, you are in contravention of Defra (or equivalent) Rules.

#### 4. ANIMAL HEALTH

Vendors with sheep showing signs of any contagious disease at any sale will be asked to remove the sheep from the market premises immediately and those sheep will not be offered for sale. Where necessary the whole consignment may have to be removed. If a vet is called, and supports the Society decision, the fees incurred will be the responsibility of the vendor.

#### **5. SELLING SHEEP**

Members are encouraged to sell their sheep in larger lots as purchasers are looking for a number of animals.

### 6. **BALLYMENA SALE ONLY**

Exhibitor must pay a fee on sale day to cover veterinary charges needed to comply with DARD export regulations.

### 7. RAM GUARANTEES

If a ram has been used, or semen retained, the owner must declare it in the catalogue or at the time of sale. It is up to the buyer to ascertain this before purchasing.
