Applesham farm, Coombes, Lancing, West Sussex, BN15 0RP

Applesham farm is an 850 acre mixed farm in the South Downs National Park. It is a family partnership owned and run by Hugh and Christopher Passmore and has been farmed by the family for over one hundred years. The farm has an arable enterprise a suckler herd and a flock of sheep.

The sheep flock comprises 180 Lley's and 200 Texel cross Lley's run on a commercial basis producing finished lambs and replacement ewes. The Lleys are either kept pure or crossed with a Texel to provide crossbred ewes. Lambing is outdoors in April after the ewes have spent the winter grazing forage crops and summer grazing is on grass leys which have a high clover content and receive no fertiliser.
