CODE OF CONDUCT

The Society expects its Members to:

- (1) Adhere to animal health and welfare standards set by DEFRA.
- (2) Conform to other procedures required by DEFRA, re: for example, identification of stock, movement of stock etc.
- (3) Record accurately the information required by the Society for registration of Sheep.
- (4) Register with the Society only those sheep that meet the pedigree requirements of the Society and the Breed Characteristics published from time to time by the Society.
- (5) Identify individual sheep registered with the Society in the manner specified by the Society.
- (6) Present sheep at Society Sales in a manner conforming to the Society requirements, e.g. the sheep should not be trimmed or coloured in any way, and in a state consistent with breed promotion, i.e. the sheep should be clean, in good health, not suffering from any transmittable disease etc.
- (7). Give information in writing to the Society's Secretary without delay of every case of alleged misrepresentation or inaccuracy in the particulars furnished by any Society Member with reference to the pedigree or identity of any animal, and to assist the Officers of the Society to investigate any such case.

In addition the Society may add to the above any such definitions under this heading as Council may resolve from time to time.
