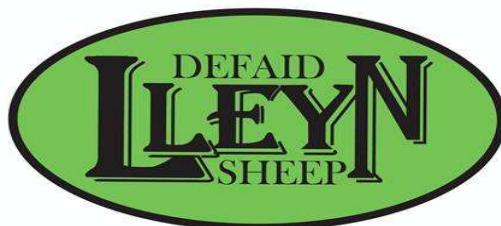

3. All animals are at the risk of the vendor before sale and at the risk of the purchaser after the sale.
4. The service dates, while believed to be correct, cannot however, be guaranteed.
5. The Auctioneer reserves the right to refuse to accept bids from a vendor and they reserve on behalf of themselves and of the vendor the following rights.
  - a) to fix a reserve price.
  - b) to bid on behalf of a vendor.
  - c) to rearrange, consolidate or withdraw any lots or vary the order of sale, and
  - d) without giving any reason therefore, to refuse to accept the bids of any person .
6. All sheep will be sold in guineas.

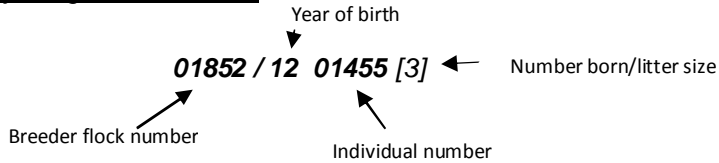

## LLEYN BREED CHARACTERISTICS

The Ideal Lleyn	
<i>Revised January 2010, and supersedes all previous details of the Lleyn breed</i>	
<b>HEAD</b>	Distinctive and feminine; warm white in colour; wide forehead; good length from eye to nose, straight to slightly dished and narrowing towards the nose; bright' lively eyes; black nose.
<b>EARS</b>	Medium size and thickness and black spots desirable; base preferably starting from the wool.
<b>NECK</b>	Average length, well set on shoulders
<b>BREAST</b>	Wide and well forward
<b>SHOULDER</b>	Well set.
<b>RIB</b>	Long and well arched.
<b>BACK</b>	Good length
<b>LOIN</b>	Broad; well joined to rump, well set tail
<b>LEGS</b>	Average length, with no wool lower than the hock. Colour warm white.
<b>BONE</b>	Flat.
<b>TAIL</b>	The tail should be docked according to current practice.
<b>WOOL</b>	Containing no hemp, of good length, dense and of high quality.
<b>RAMS</b>	Hornless.

## **THE LLEYN BREED**

### **THE SHEEP BREED OF THE FUTURE**

What is so remarkable about this breed?

Thirty years ago it was almost unknown outside the small Lleyln peninsula which stretches out to the sea towards Ireland in the North West corner of Wales, and is now found in every corner of the British Isles and more recently in Ireland.

There are very good reasons for the spread and growth of the Lleyln, despite the extreme difficulty experienced by non Welsh speaking people in pronouncing it's name.

The Lleyln ewe is an excellent mother in all respects. She lambs easily, attends to her newborn lambs without any fuss but with great enthusiasm, whether she is an older ewe or a ewe lamb lambing for the first time. She is an excellent milker and new born lambs are remarkably quick getting on their feet and to suckle, particularly important when lambing takes place outside in weather conditions that are not ideal.

A mature Lleyln flock in regular ages will naturally rear a 200% crop of lambs with ease, while the ewe lamb section of the flock, which are very often mated, will result in a "bonus" crop of lambs.

The Lleyln is a naturally healthy breed and this combined with the ability to maintain a "closed" flock, ensures the maintenance of a high health status flock.

Compared with many other breeds, used to produce prime lamb the Lleyln is smaller in size and enables a higher stocking rate to be maintained and a consequent higher sale of lambs per acre, whether bred pure or crossed with a terminal breed sire, the Lleyln produces highly satisfactory carcase lambs, classified "U"'s and "R"'s, when based on good grassland systems of production, with minimum or nil concentrate use.

The Lleyln ram is also in considerable demand to cross on to other breeds, particularly hill and upland breeds to increase lambing percentages of the resultant breeding ewes, and to improve carcase quality.

The Lleyln is a wonderful ewe, it is little wonder that her fame has, and still is, spreading so rapidly, and that Lleyln breeders are so enthusiastic about her performance.

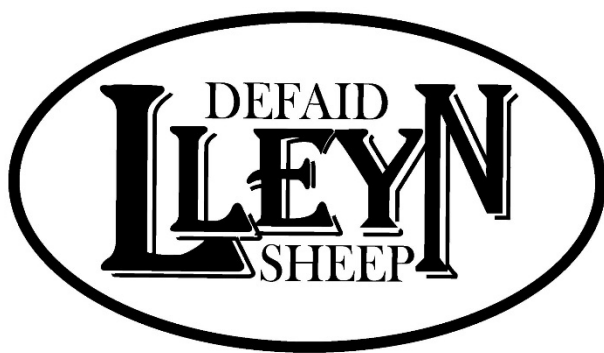
