The 2015 AGM weekend is taking place in Devon, the decision to move to different venues round the country has been well received.


As a breed we must continue to look forward and work together to always improve. The Society is always keen to hear from breeders so please do come and meet us at the summer events.




Something for you to consider Selling Females in Batches

It was noted at many of the 2014 sales that breeders were increasingly selling all their sheep in small batches i.e. groups of 5. Although this works for the occasional show pen or the buyer looking for small numbers of pedigree type sheep it does not suit the commercial buyer (the buyer who has come for larger quantities). Selling many sheep in small numbers can be negative as it slows the momentum of the sale. Therefore it is recommended to sell the odd pen/pens in five and the others in 10, 15 20 and more. This could help attract more of those commercial buyers to the ringside, hence

ARE YOU TAGGING YOUR REGISTERED LLEYN EWE LAMBS CORRECTLY?



There are two options for tagging ewe lambs. most common one used is where you tag the lambs with double tags ordered from your own tag supplier that are Government approved. The LSS requires you to have your Society flock number and year of birth printed on the secondary tag as well as the UK/IE tag number.

EWE LAMB REGISTRATION



Your 2015 ewe lamb registrations are now due!

Please note the registration fee for all ewe lambs born in 2015, registered on or before 31° October 2015 will be charged at £1.50 + VAT or €2.10. For all those registrations received in the office after this date, the fee increases to £2 + VAT or €2.80 each.

Therefore it is cheaper to get your ewe lambs registrations sent into the office before 1st November! You can do this by spreadsheet, online or paper form.

Ewe Lambs at Sales

Remember - ewe lambs (as all sheep) must be registered before being presented for sale. At Society sales the Society will be undertaking spot checks.

The Council will be notified of any breeder presenting sheep which is not registered before sale with relevant penalties being applied where necessary.

Don't forget purchasers can now check this information themselves on any computer or phone with Internet access. Any fully paid up member of the Society has access to the Online Flock Book & Registry at all times.

Purchasers may be eligible to return sheep which have been incorrectly sold as registered.



There is the option on the Ram forms to name your rams. For rams born in 2014 (Shearling Rams) names must start with the letter 'D'. That could be 'D' for Dean, Dandy, Donald or Dynamo.

Upset Price Don't forget when selecting your rams for inspection/registration; there is an upset price of 250gns or €300 at Society sales.

Testicle Size Concerns have been raised about the small testicles of some rams at sale time. Please be aware of this.



OUTSTANDING MATERNAL PERFORMANCE

The Society has launched the above scheme with full details available on pages 95 - 100 in the 2015 Society handbook.

The Breed Development Committee has put together the scheme with the objective for breeders to identify their most productive ewes hence giving you more information to help you decide which ewes to keep for replacements and which to consider for culling. The long term goal is for the breeder to increase the productivity of their flock. With increased numbers of breeders undertaking the scheme the effects should be felt further with an increased productivity across the breed. By increasing productivity and better still backed up by figures, we could have a strong marketing tool for the future.

The scheme is very much voluntary but the Society encourages breeders to take part.

SUMMARY

Based on weighing lambs at 8 weeks and ewes at weaning

Performance Efficiency = weight of lambs ÷ weight of ewe

Data gathered on-farm by the breeder, for the breeder.

Only the Flock Average figure to be sent to the Society.

The Society will produce flock average figures for breeders' information and promotions, i.e. overall; regional; lowland/upland/hill.
