Completing the form

As a member of the Society you are invited to enter sheep in to this autumn's official Society sales. You can use the enclosed form to enter in to any of the sales but please remember to:

- Clearly write the sale to which you are entering your sheep (use a different form for each sale)
- Please complete and answer all questions as the information will be included in the sales catalogue
- Also remember to sign the entry form otherwise your entry will not be accepted
- If you need extra copies either photo copy or download from the website <u>www.lleynsheep.com</u>

Registration of sheep

- Ewes and rams presented for sale *must* be registered prior to the closing date. <u>Ewe lambs must have</u> <u>been registered prior to the day of sale.</u> The Society does run spot checks to ascertain whether sheep have been registered before the sale.
 - Random checks will be made to ensure that all sheep have been properly tagged.
- Remember to enclose the pedigree certificates for the rams entered. As the inspection dates for some venues are later it is anticipated that the pedigree certificates for those yearling rams will not be sent out in time for you to enter if you want to send in your entry forms before receiving the pedigree certificates could you please give me a ring to hold back those certificates for the rams entered for the sale.

MVA & Scrapie Paperwork

- In relation to Maedi Visna Accreditation (MVA), there are two sections offered at all UK mainland sales. MVA and non MVA. (Note: Maedi Visna supervised flocks can only sell in non MVA)
- Members selling MVA Sheep, please complete a valid certificate of accreditation issued by SAC and hand it to Auctioneers' staff before unloading your animals. NO MV FORM NO SALE
- At the Ballymena Sale all sheep must be accompanied by a Scrapie Certificate.

No Entry Fee

The Society does not charge an entry fee at any Society Sale. Every member is therefore asked to consider carefully before selling their stock from home – please support the official sales where you can!

Sending your entry form

- Please send your entry form to me NOT the Auctioneers. Send by post or email.
- Please remember to affix the right amount of postage, incorrect postage can delay your entry. LATE ENTRIES CANNOT BE ACCEPTED.
- Only signed entry forms can be accepted.
- Send your ram certificates with the entry. If you email the entry form, please post the rams certificates to arrive before the closing date. Ensure you state which sale the certificates apply to.

Rams

Ram and ram lamb entries are only accepted according to the following sliding scale:

(i) To sell 1 ram/ram lamb you must present a minimum of 0 ewes/ewe lambs at the Sale

2 rams/ram lambs you must present a minimum of
3 rams/ram lambs you must present a minimum of
4 rams/ram lambs you must present a minimum of
6 rams/ram lambs you must present a minimum of
6 rams/ram lambs you must present a minimum of

6 ewes/ewe lambs

- (ii) <u>SIX</u> rams/ram lambs is the maximum that will be accepted at any one sale per flock.
- (iii) There is no limit to the number of females which can be entered.
- (iv) In the case that a Vendor is unable to bring females to a sale, then that Vendor will only be allowed to sell one ram at that sale (not the whole consignment). A Vendor presenting a reduced number of females at any one sale must comply with the existing sliding scale for the number of rams allowed (sliding scale as above).

Entry fee allowing ram/female ratio exemption - only operative at time of entry/before closing date

The current ram-female ratio remains. Up to 3 rams for a sale treat the same. Should the breeder wish to bring 4 - 6 rams without enough females they must pay a £50+vat (€70+vat)/head entry fee for the extra rams, payable to the Society at time of entering (non-refundable). For example, a breeder wishes to bring 6 rams and 20 females – they would pay £150+vat entry fee (3 x £50+vat). Another breeder brings 60 females and 6 rams = no charge or 4 rams and 30 females = £50 + vat (1x£50 + vat).

Ram Lambs

- a) If you wish to enter a **ram lamb**, please do so in the usual manner fill in the enclosed ram lamb registration form and the animal will be inspected on the morning of the sale. You must understand that should this ram lamb fail then he will **not** be allowed to be sold through the ring.
- b) Please use the same form (enclosed with this letter) if you wish to have your ram lambs inspected at a later date the deadline for receiving applications to provisionally register ram lambs is 30th November, 2019.
- c) All members will have the opportunity to know the reason why his/her animal(s) was/were rejected by the Panel/Inspector. This information will be available by one of the Officials at the sale, immediately after the Panel/Inspector has/have completed his/their work

Ram Guarantees

If a ram has been used, or semen retained, the owner must declare it in the catalogue or at the time of sale. It is up to the buyer to ascertain this before purchasing.

Shearing, Trimming and colouring of wool

It is brought to the attention of all Vendors that:

- (i) The latest date allowed for shearing of sheep is 15th July.
- (ii) NO TRIMMING of male or female sheep prior to the sale is allowed.
- (iii) The Society discourages artificial colouring of wool.

Unofficial sales of stock

The practice of selling any sheep from the backs of vehicles at Auctioneers' premises during official Sales is prohibited by the Society. The Auctioneers have agreed that any Vendor selling sheep unofficially at the Society Sales will be asked to leave the premises. You are also reminded that, in pursuing this practice, you are in contravention of Defra (or equivalent) rules.

Animal Health

Vendors with sheep showing signs of any contagious disease at any sale will be asked to remove the sheep from the market premises immediately and those sheep will not be offered for sale. Where necessary the whole consignment may have to be removed. If a vet is called, and supports the Society decision, the fees incurred will be the responsibility of the vendor.

Sheep Inspection

A panel chosen by the Society's Council will inspect all sheep from outside the pen, but if a problem arises then the Panel will have authority to go into that pen. NOTE: The <u>Panel's decision if final</u> and any query arising from the Inspector's decision should be direct to the Secretary or other Society Representative on the day of sale.

Females Batches

Members are encouraged to sell their ewes and ewe lambs in larger lots as purchasers are looking for a number of animals.

Shows at the sales

Clubs have organised shows before most of the sales – details are available on the website www.lleynsheep.com or by contacting the Club Secretaries direct.

General Information

- a) Refer to the sales catalogues for sale, penning and show times
- b) The Society encourages members to declare their genotype results of the ram in the comment box on the ram form. (Export from UK requires DEFRA (or equivalent) approved testing).
- c) Enclosed is a polite reminder on sheep health at official Society sales please have a quick read!

Special Rules - NSA BUILTH WELLS RAM SALE - MONDAY 23rd SEPTEMBER 2019

Regards the NSA Builth Wells Ram Sale, those of you who sold rams at the Builth Wells Sale last year will receive an entry form automatically for this year's sale. If you wish to sell at the Sale and have not received a form please let me know or visit the NSA website. May I remind you that the Lleyn Sheep Society's conditions of sale and the National Sheep Association's sale bye-laws are in force for this sale.

Please note the following points as regards entering for the NSA sale:

- a) For registered rams, the entry form, entry fee and ram certificates should be sent **to me** and **not** to the National Sheep Association **nor** the Auctioneers, Ruthin Farmers;
- b) Closing date Tuesday, 30th July, 2019
- c) Cheques for the N.S.A fee should be **made payable to Ruthin Farmers.** Please see the fees due in the N.S.A. Bylaws.
- d) Un-registered Rams Members will be allowed to enter unregistered Lleyn to this sale. Details of these unregistered rams should be sent directly to the auctioneers. Ruthin Farmers Auction Co Ltd. Parc Glasdir, Ruthin, Denbighshire LL15 1PB. Details of these rams <u>will not be</u> included in the sales catalogue. These rams will be sold after the end of the registered section.
- e) PLEASE NOTE that all registered rams <u>must be registered prior to entry</u> but you will be allowed to enter yearling rams which the Inspector has 'put on hold' during the official inspections and also ram lambs. If you fall into either of these categories please:
 - i. State the centre at which the ram/rams was/were inspected and 'put on hold':
 - ii. Let me have details of the ram(s) which is/are 'on hold';
 - iii. Complete the necessary form for ram lambs (pages 9-10) and return with the appropriate fee please see fees on page 4.

Pre-Sale Show - The Society will be holding a Show on the morning of the sale – details on the website. All animals competing *must* be registered.

Conditions of Sale

The Conditions of Sale can be viewed on the website, www.lleynsheep.com and a copy will be displayed at each sale – should you wish to receive a hard copy, please contact me.

Special Note - Ballymena Sale

Exhibitors must pay a fee on sale day to cover veterinary charges needed to comply with DARD export regulations.

Registration of Ewe Lambs

A form has already been sent out to you to register this year's crop of ewe lambs – this can be done online, on email with a spreadsheet or the paper form. The closing date for registering ewe lambs born in 2019 is 31st December 2019. However, if you are selling ewe lambs at one of the official sales then you must register these prior to the sale day and tag according to Government regulations and Society rules.



Polite Notice

If your sheep are showing signs of a contagious disease (e.g. Orf, New Forest), the 'Society Sale Inspectors' may ask for some or all of your consignment to be removed from the sale.

Note: If this means that you do not have enough females forward to sell the number of rams you have entered, your rams or some of your rams may not be sold.

If you have concerns speak to the Society Office or Society Chairman before bringing your sheep to the sale.

Lleyn Sheep Society - Sale Inspector Panel Guidelines

It is advised the sale inspection panel follows these guidelines when undertaking an inspection at a Lleyn Sheep Society Sale.

WHEN IS THE INSPECTION, AND WHO ARE THE INSPECTORS

- The inspection panel is made up of the nominated Senior Sales Officer and the nominated members. These nominations are made by the Society Council
- The inspection is to take place from outside the pens prior to the start of the sale

All Female Sheep

HEALTH

Any sheep showing signs of a live contagious disease (e.g. orf, new forest) must be removed from the sale
centre, where necessary the whole pen may be removed, i.e. where there is seen to be a high percentage of
infected stock in the pen.

TYPE/COSMETIC/STANDARD

- All sheep must comply with breed standards
- No trimming is allowed
- Colouring is discouraged
- Black patches are to be dealt with on an individual basis at the discretion of the inspection panel
- It is left to the Inspection panel on the day to make the necessary decision. If it is felt that sheep do not fit the necessary expectations, the inspectors can ask the vendor to remove them from the sale.

QUALITY/CONDITION

• If the inspectors believe that animals are detrimental to the sale, breed and Society, they can ask the vendor to remove those in question from the sale.

TAGGING

 A random check should be done across the female sheep to ensure they are tagged in accordance with the Society rules (the Society flock number and year of birth MUST be printed on the secondary tag or a third tag that could be a Society Tag.)

SLIDING SCALE/ENTRIES FORWARD

- The inspectors should make a note where possible of the females forward against the number of rams. They should pay special attention to empty pens and large entries of rams.
- If a breeder has to remove females and it means that they do not have enough females forward to present the number of rams entered, the said breeder may be asked to remove some of their rams from the sale.

ACTION TO BE TAKEN

- Ultimately the Senior Sales Officer and the Inspection panel must make the necessary decision on the day. It is asked that common sense is used so that everyone can get the best out of the Society sales.
- Where necessary the panel may ask for sheep to be removed from the sale
- All offenders must be noted and reported to the Promotions Committee for the October meeting so that where necessary letters of highlight can be sent to try and resolve the issue for another year.
- For long term re-occurring offenders, the Society can undertake flock inspections.

All Rams

It is advised that the inspection panel observes the rams for health and condition. They should also consider the trimming & colouring rules. The sliding scale rule must be noted. The panel should use its discretion when observing the rams and undertake action where felt necessary.

- 1. A ram lamb is to be entered for Provisional Registration by the breeder ONLY.
- 2. A ram lamb which is to be used for pedigree breeding in the breeder's own flock or any other flock, must be inspected:
 - i. At a Society sale by an Inspector appointed by the officials
 - ii. Failing this, the ram lamb is to be inspected on farm or a chosen centre, by an inspector appointed by the officials, this is to be at the expense of the breeder.
- 3. Deadline for receiving applications to provisionally register ram lamb(s) is <u>30th November</u>. After this date ram lambs can no longer be processed as lambs, they would need to be entered directly as a shearling the following summer.
- 4. This application must be received in the Society Office at least 5 days prior to any pre scheduled day of inspection.
- 5. Inspection can only be undertaken if this form is received in this office, fully completed with full payment.

To obtain FULL REGISTRATION he must be returned as a shearling

Please note that if your ram lamb passes the inspection he will only be provisionally registered until he is a shearling. To get him fully registered, he must be entered into a summer inspections as a shearling ram. He must pass these inspections to be tagged with an official Society tag and receive a certificate. Once he has this he is registered for life.
